RULES FOR MONTY TECH SUMMER SCHOOL 2017

1. **Tuition:** Payment for classes must be made prior to the course beginning, and payment must be in cash, bank check, or credit card (MasterCard, Visa, or Discover only). We will not be accepting personal checks. There are no payment plans offered for Summer School.

NO refunds will be made unless the course is canceled due to lack of enrollment.

2. **Attendance Policy:** More than two (2) absences will result in a failing grade for the course and loss of credit, with no refund.

Tardy: 10 minutes equals one absence.

3. Transportation **will not** be provided. The student is responsible for his or her own transportation.
4. Students will not be allowed in the building during unscheduled class time, unless they are scheduled for a morning and afternoon class.
5. There will be no lunches served; however, there will be sandwiches available in the vending machines.
6. Any student who fails English, Math and/or Science must make up the class the summer immediately following the year the class was taken in order to be promoted.
7. At the discretion of the Summer School Director, the student may be withdrawn with no credit and no refund due to disciplinary issues. Please see the Student Handbook at www.montytech.net
8. Students will use the parking lot and entrance on the Fitchburg side of the building.
9. Skateboards are not permitted on the school grounds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Progress reports will not be included in the Summer School grading process.
- Some Summer School courses may be offered as online courses. Classroom attendance is mandatory for online classes.
- Students and parents must read and agree to abide by the rules and regulations above.

- Final grades will be sent to the student and his/her school.
